



# A/ Technical Requirements





## 1. Coaches

**1.1** Each trainer for each shooting game shall obtain a qualification license from the Saudi Shooting Federation to practice training.

This license shall be renewed annually after fulfilling the following conditions:

1. The trainer shall have specialized training certificates in the field of shooting.
2. Providing a medical report on the psychological and neurological condition annually.
3. Passing the Interview.
4. The trainer shall obtain courses in security and safety from the academies under the supervision of the Saudi Shooting Federation.
5. Submitting a CV for the Federation

## 2. Facilities

**2.1 Facilities:** Shooting clubs and their facilities are subject to special control systems , laws and regulations due to the sensitivity of the equipment and tools in which shooting sport is practiced. The Saudi Shooting Federation has set definitions and guidelines for the clubs' regulations and requirements.

**2.2 Shooting Club Definition:** It is a sports, social and recreational facility with a legal personality owned by the private sector and is licensed to work by the Ministry of Sports in the aspect of sports activity in accordance with the legal procedures in force in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia. The Shooting Sport is practiced in those shooting clubs with individual and sports arms for practicing the shooting hobby and preparing athletes for local and international competitions, in accordance with the programs of the Saudi Shooting Federation, through activities and programs that are compatible with the issued rules and regulations by the concerned authorities (Ministry of Commerce, Ministry of Interior “The Permanent Committee for Shooting Clubs - Civil Defense” and Ministry of Municipal, Rural Affairs and Housing) and under the supervision of the Saudi Shooting Federation.






## 3. Equipment

**3.1** The used tools in shooting were classified and a guide was developed for these tools, in accordance with the following:

1. [Weapons, ammunition, equipment, tools and sportswear for rifle shooting.](#)
2. [Weapons, ammunition, equipment, tools and sports apparel for pistol shooting.](#)
3. [Weapons, ammunition, equipment, tools and sports apparel for shooting shotguns.](#)





## 3. Equipment

### 3.2 The Following shall be provided:

1. Sporting arms according to the Saudi Shooting Federation specifications ([Pistol](#) - [Rifle](#) - [Shotgun](#)).
2. Olympic sports ammunition according to the Saudi Shooting Federation specifications ([Air and Firearms for Pistols](#) - [Air and Firearms for Rifles](#) - [Shotgun Ammunition](#)).
3. Crockery for shooting shotguns (regular and flash). ([Crockery Details](#))
4. Special clothes for shooting rifles, and the facility can rent these clothes to shooters or sell them. ([Details](#))
5. Special shoes for shooting rifles, and the facility can rent these shoes to shooters or sell them. ([Details](#))
6. Shooting jackets for skeet shooting (shotguns), and the facility can rent these jackets to shooters or sell them. ([Details](#))
7. Shooting glasses for skeet shooting (shotguns), and the facility can rent these glasses to shooters or sell them. ([Details](#))
8. Sound-proofing headphones for shooting dishes, and the facility can these headphones to shooters or sell them. ([Details](#))

***With the need to obtain the Federation opinion regarding the tools related to the shooting sport by virtue of jurisdiction.***



## 4. Safety

**4.1** Upon acceptance of the player, the player is required to submit a medical examination stating that the participant is medically fit and the club is held the full responsibility for that.

**4.2** Having a certified physiotherapist for the team or a valid contract with a clinic from the Saudi Federation for Health Specialties. In the event that a specialist is available but not accredited, one can apply for accreditation by filling out the following form by the Saudi Federation for Sports Medicine (SFSM) <http://sfsm.org.sa/mos30>

**4.3 First Aid** - Provide first aid kit with adequate equipment as it's stipulated here <http://sfsm.org.sa/mos70> as per SFSM's minimum standards, and to have an ambulance car during games & tournaments (if available).

- ✓ **Small Bag:** SAR 12,650 (up to 50 persons)
- ✓ **Large bag:** SAR 14,375 (up to 100 persons)

**4.4 Fire alarm system according to the requirements of the Civil Defense**



## 4. Safety

- 4.5 Security and Safety are the most important requirement in accordance with the Regulations of the Saudi Shooting Federation.
- 4.6 The safety of the players, organizers and fans is an ongoing requirement during all times of training or competition.
- 4.7 Enforcing careful attention to the arms, to ensure safety as all arms shall be handled with the utmost care and attention at all times.
- 4.8 When moving an arm out of throwing range, the player shall have its arms in its bag.
- 4.9 When transporting the arm within the firing range and without its bag, the player shall take out the bolt group and place the safety flag on the barrel.
- 4.10 Ammunition shall be out of the arm at all times except when the command "start", or "load" is heard.
- 4.11 Safety flags shall be made of phosphor orange or similar shiny material. (Adding a picture as an example)
- 4.12 The safety flag shall be on all arms at all times except when the command 'start', 'load' or 'fill' is heard or when the green light is seen.



## 4. Safety

- 4.13 Players while at the throwing points shall aim their arms in a safe direction and the arm shall not be locked until the start, load or loud command is issued.
- 4.14 When placing the arms to leave the firing point and when the shooting is finished, you shall ensure that the arms is free of ammunition, open the bolt and insert the safety flag before leaving.
- 4.15 When arms are not at throwing points, the arms shall be in their crates unless the field officer instructs otherwise.
- 4.16 Shotguns shall be empty and open (broken) at all times except at the point of firing.
- 4.17 Dry training and unloading of arms are permitted on the throwing points or in a designated area for that.
- 4.18 The importance of wearing ear protectors and glasses to protect the eyes for all visitors to the facility, whether it is a shooter, audience, technical staff, administrative staff or worker.



## 5. Competition

- 5.1** The Federation issues the requirements and instructions regulating internal and external participation, whether in camps, championships or competitions, and circulates them to academies and sports clubs to work accordingly

## 5. Competition

### 5.3 The competitions shall be organized in accordance with the Competition Regulation of the Saudi Shooting Federation:

- 5.3.1 The Competitions shall be organized under the supervision and follow-up of the Saudi Shooting Federation.
- 5.3.2 Each club shall prepare the shooters technically and establish a team that will compete in all shooting competitions.
- 5.3.3 Registration of clubs, governmental or private sectors in the Saudi Shooting Federation at the beginning of each season (at the beginning of the Gregorian year) to ensure obtaining a copy of the internal schedule for the competitions.
- 5.3.4 Sending the names of the participants in the Saudi Shooting Federation championships (15) days before the start of the championship.
- 5.3.5 The Federation allows late registration in its championships 3 days before the start of the championship, after paying a late fine of an amount 20 % of the participation fee for each player for each competition.
- 5.3.6 Attending the scheduled technical meeting for the competitions.
- 5.3.7 Determining a uniform for each team participating in the championship.
- 5.3.8 Arms and Ammunition shall be secured by the participating parties in the championships. The Organizer can rent arms and sell ammunition to the participants if possible, in accordance with the approved and followed-up mechanism.
- 5.3.9 Each side participates with a team of (3) shooters for each competition and for each category.



## 5. Competition

### 5.3 cont/ The competitions shall be organized in accordance with the Competition Regulation of the Saudi Shooting Federation:

- 5.3.10** The shooter cannot participate in any competition until he obtains a player card from the organizing committee of the Saudi Shooting Federation (SSF).
- 5.3.11** The Organizing Committee or the Arbitration committee shall have the right to exclude any person whose name is not included in the records of the official participants in the championship or who influences the competitor, whether by word or deed.
- 5.3.12** Each participating authority shall have the right to be accompanied by a referee holding an approved classification, without the organizer incurring any financial or administrative obligations.
- 5.3.13** The participating team in the championship shall be accompanied by (administrator and trainer for each game and a weapon keeper in case the weapon belongs to the participating team).
- 5.3.14** In the event of any emergency that was not mentioned or referred to, a temporary committee will be formed, its members consisting of the championship director, a member of the organizing committee, the head of the championship referees committee or its representative to study and decide on this situations.

## B/ Administrative Requirements





## 6. Membership

- 6.1** To obtain membership in the federation, the club must submit an application to the Saudi Shooting Federation two months before the start of the season with the following attachments:
- ❖ A statement of the names, qualifications and experiences of the technical and supervisors team of the game.
  - ❖ A statement including the existing facilities, stadiums and equipment
  - ❖ A pledge of compliance with the regulations, decisions and regulations promulgated by the Federation.
  - ❖ Receipt of the prescribed fees payment for joining the federation's membership

***It is thereby activated after obtaining the commercial registration from the Ministry of Commerce and the licensing from the Ministry of Sports.***

- 6.2** The board of directors of the federation shall review the request and issue its decision within 30 (thirty) days from the commencement date on which the request was submitted by the general secretariat of the federation.
- 6.3** The Saudi Shooting Federation investigates and confirms the technical requirements.



## 6. Membership

**6.4** The applicant shall be notified of the decision of the Board of Directors within fifteen days from the date of approval on the address included in the joining application, and the Ministry shall provide a copy of the decision.

**\* An applicant for membership is considered a member of the Federation from the date of the decision issuance by the Board of Directors.**

**6.5** In the event that the application by the board of directors is rejected, the decision must be justified, and the membership applicant has the right to appeal the decision to the Ministry within 15 days from the date on which he is informed of the decision, and its decision is considered as a final settlement.

**6.6** If the membership applicant is not notified of the decision of the board of directors officially during the periods referred to in the aforementioned paragraphs, then he has the right to elevate the matter to the Ministry to take the final decision within thirty days of its receipt

**6.7 Membership period:** The membership period for clubs, individuals and teams shall not be less than one year and not more than four years in accordance the internal regulations of the Federation



## 7. Fees

**7.1** The stipulated fees in accordance with the financial regulations of the Saudi Shooting Federation shall be collected as follows:

**7.1.1** License Fees (50,000 Saudi Riyals)

**7.1.2** Membership Fees (300 Saudi Riyals).

**7.1.3** Training License Fee (1,000 Saudi Riyals).

**7.1.4** Arms and Ammunition Registration Fees (1,000 Saudi Riyals)

**7.1.5** Competition Organization Fees (1,000 Saudi Riyals)

**7.1.6** Shooters Registration fees and Issuing an International Number Fees (100 Saudi Riyals)



## 8. Violations & Penalties

- 8.1 The principles of security must be adhered to and safety conditions must be applied within facilities and during competitions
- 8.2 The public taste system shall be applied during sports competitions
- 8.3 The regulations of the Saudi Shooting Federation apply to the game during sports competitions
- 8.4 Sports violations that are not mentioned in the shooting law can be found on the discipline and ethics regulation of the Saudi Shooting Federation ([Regulation Link](#)) and it will be is applied
