



Squash Technical Regulations for Private Academies



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A/ Technical Requirements





1. Coaches

- 1.1 Coaches shall have preparation coaching certificate (1st level) (for the national coaches)
- 1.2 Coaches shall have an intermediate course certificate (2nd level) accredited by his/her squash federation (for the foreign coaches)
- 1.3 Coaches shall obtain a first aid certificate or the player injuries certificate.
- 1.4 Coaches shall hold a general secondary school certificate as a minimum.
- 1.5 A minimum of one coach for every 15 player





2. Facilities

- 2.1 Provide no less than two courts for male and female.
- 2.2 Provide restrooms for each court.
- 2.4 Provide a first aid room.
- 2.5 The court must comply with the specifications in accordance with WorldSquash and it shall be indoors, the specifications can be found here. <https://www.worldsquash.org/court-construction/>
- 2.6 The wooden flooring must be used as what is stipulated in the International Federation regulations.
- 2.7 Provide a warehouse to store the equipment or a storage space.
- 2.8 The lighting should be a good beam spread with 8 LED lighting squares. Each square contains 2 lamps distributed and covering the entire court.
- 2.9 Provide exhaust fans for ventilation.
- 2.10 Provide a minimum of 20 public seats for fans and parents.
- 2.11 The air conditioning shall distribute in the courts and spectator areas



3. Equipment

- 3.1 Provide squash rackets (e.g dunlop - prince - tecnifibre).
- 3.2 Provide Squash ball.
- 3.3 Provide Squash goggles for participants with the age of 19 or under.





4. Safety

4.1 First aid supplies must be available at all times,

4.2 Provide around the clock security at the academy (not mandatory)

4.3 Upon acceptance of the player, the player is required to submit a medical examination stating that the participant is medically fit and the academy is held the full responsibility for that.

4.4 Having a certified physiotherapist for the team or a valid contract with a clinic from the Saudi Federation for Health Specialties. In the event that a specialist is available but not accredited, one can apply for accreditation by filling out the following form by the Saudi Federation for Sports Medicine (SFSM) <http://sfsm.org.sa/mos30>

4. Safety

4.5 First Aid - Provide first aid kit with adequate equipment as it's stipulated here <http://s fsm.org.sa/mos70> as per SFSM's minimum standards, and to have an ambulance car during games & tournaments (if available).

4.6 Fire alarm system according to the requirements of the Civil Defense



5. Competition

- 5.1** The academy can participate in the federation's championships if the academy is accredited by the Ministry of Sports.
- 5.2** The academy shall register in the tournaments according to the federation schedule and tournaments programs, which is announced prior to the commencement of each season, and they are 25 domestic championships.
- 5.3** The Saudi Arabian Olympic Committee and Federations issues the conditions and instructions regulating the internal and external participations, whether in training camps, tournaments or competitions, and circulates them to the sports federations to work in accordance with them.



B/ Administrative Requirements





6. Affiliation

- 6.1 The age of the players are not less than 6 years
- 6.2 The parent to register the players who are less than 15 years old
- 6.3 The Gregorian calendar to be official birthdate when registering the player
- 6.4 Creating training schedules for each category (junior and senior) and abiding by it.





7. Fees

7.1 The annual affiliation fees for the accredited academy is (5,000 SAR) and it shall be deposited in the Federation's official bank account

***Note:**

The accreditation: is the academy that fulfills all the requirements approved by the ministry and gotten the in order to be eligible to participate in the federation's tournaments programs.





8. Violations & Penalties

- 8.1** If the academy violates any of the technical, safety and security requirements as listed in the document, the academy shall be given a notice period of 30 days for correction.
- 8.2** If the academy fails to fulfill the obligations, the license shall be revoked and it is not entitled to a refund of the affiliation fees.
